

Then he receives an offer from Creative Marketing Enterprises, which includes use of an estate on Long Island. Though the setup seems bizarre, Gunn takes the job. Little does he know that he's taken the first step in the destruction of himself and his family. Gunn goes on the road trying to work up enthusiasm for a new product, the Disk, something along the lines of the old pet rock phenomenon, while his family settles into life in East Hampton. The caretaker of the title is an enigmatic man named Brady, who does much more than take care of the grounds of the estate. Brady has an elaborate plan of revenge directed toward the Hendersons, but what is the motivation for this baroque scheme? Simpson (The Fingerprints of Armless Mike, LJ 3/15/96) has

fashioned a slick, clever thriller out of an intriguing premise. Simpson's narrative voice makes the book sound at times more like a documentary: the emotional impact is often muted, and the characters never come completely to life.
